SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OF KYAA

The Khmer Youth Association of Alberta is currently accepting applications for 2011 grants. Khmer Youth Association of Alberta (KYAA) is a not-for-profitable and non-political affiliated association; and it bears no distinction of race, gender or religious faith. It was founded on May 4th, 1994 by Cambodian-Canadian Youths in Alberta.
